

# Regional Transportation Funding for Seniors & People with Disabilities

TriMet Board Briefing January 23, 2019



## **STF Agency**

- TriMet designated by State of Oregon to passthrough funding
- TriMet staff coordinates with the Special Transportation Fund Advisory Committee
  - 27 members
  - Appointed by TriMet Board on October 24, 2018



#### **STF Formula**

- Special Transportation Fund
- FY20-21 Funding Available: ~\$8,579,178
  - Potential 40% reduction
- Eligible Projects: Capital and operations for transportation services for seniors and people with disabilities.
- Eligible Applicants: Public and private nonprofit organizations



#### Section 5310

- FTA's Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities
- **FY20-21 Funding Available:** ~\$7,470,832
- Eligible Projects: Capital and operations for transportation services for seniors and people with disabilities.
- Eligible Applicants: Public and private nonprofit organizations



#### **STIF Human Services**

- Statewide Transportation Improvement Fund
- FY19-21 Funding Available: ~\$2,530,000
- **Eligible Projects:** Expansion or improvements to transportation services for seniors and people with disabilities.
- Eligible Applicants: Public and private nonprofit organizations



### **Next Steps**

- January 11, 2019: 53 applications submitted from 16 applicants
- February 8, 2019: STFAC evaluation and recommendation
- February 27, 2019: Resolution at TriMet Board Meeting
- July 1, 2019: Funds disbursed to recipients
