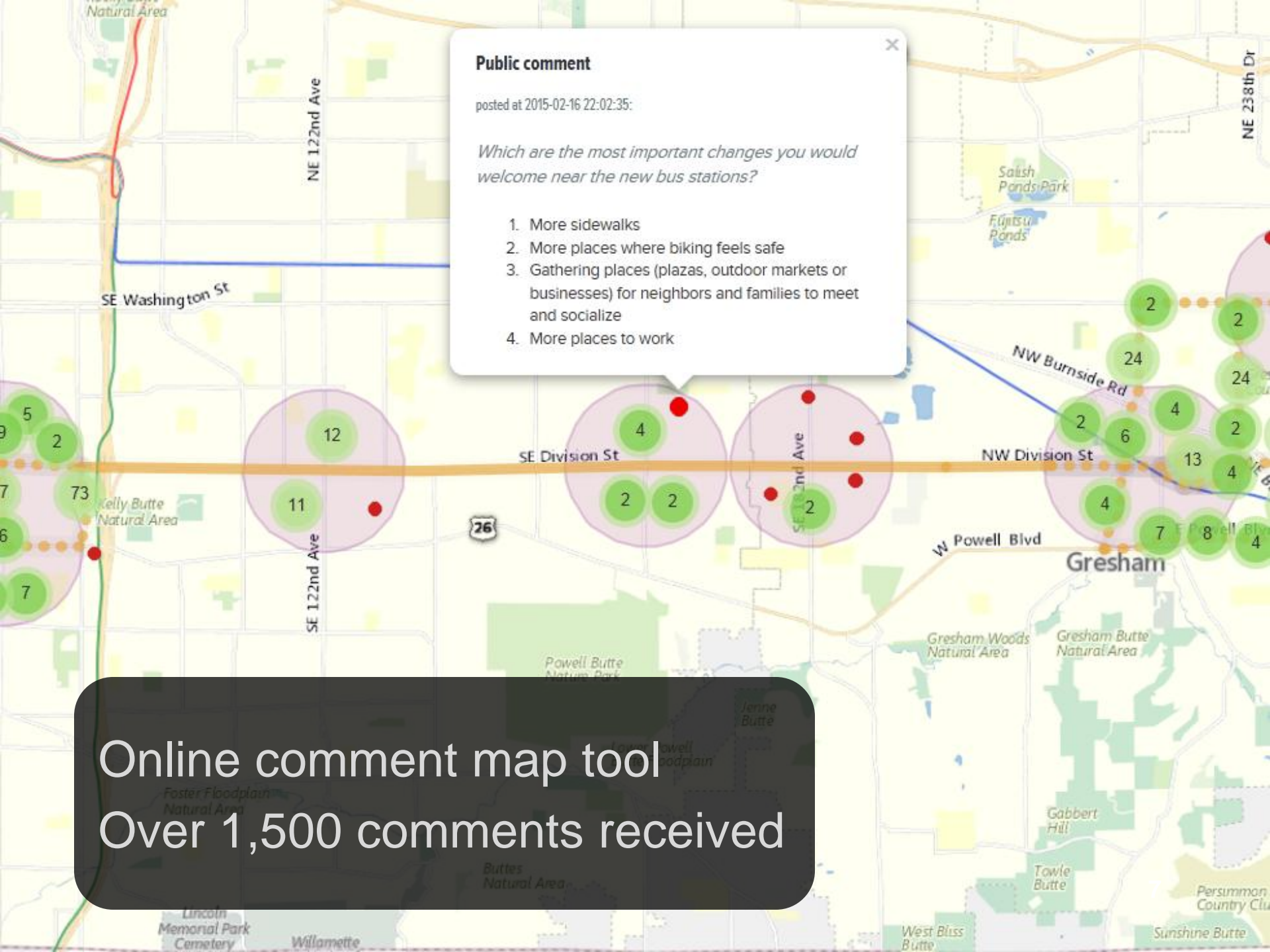

Neighborhood Prosperity Initiative & Main Street Network

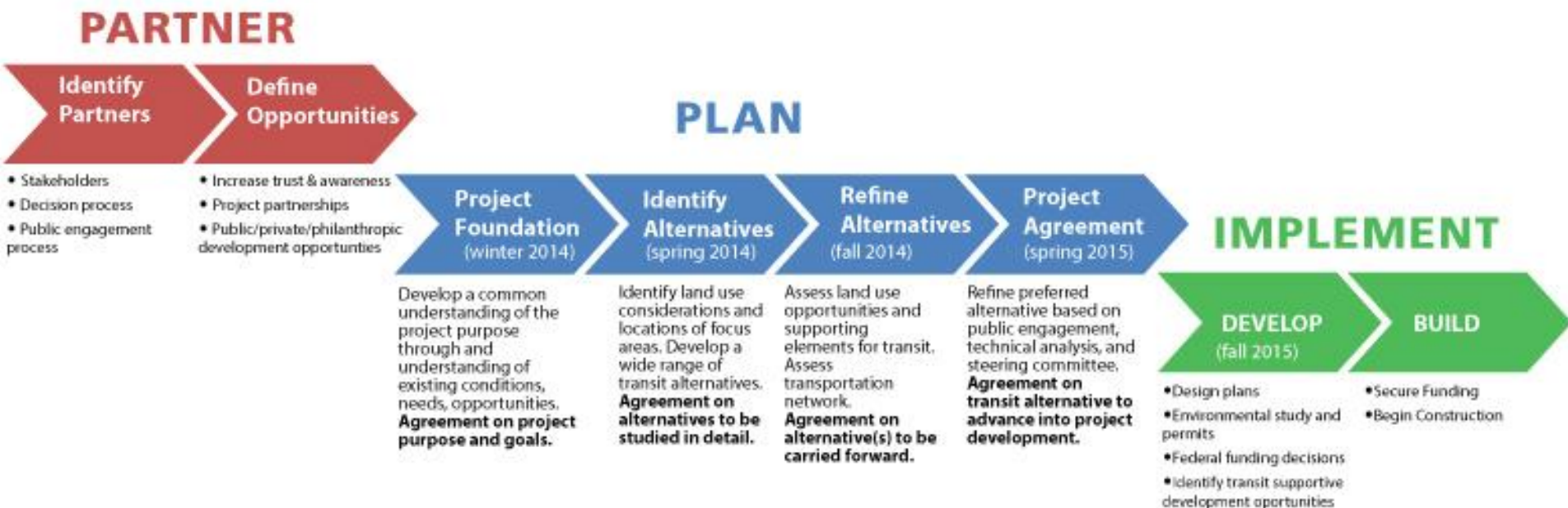


Steering Committee Advanced this Alignment with Options
