Overview

- Year-over-year program
- Approximately 35 crossings identified
 - Majority gated crossings
- Program Sponsor: Safety, Security & Environmental Dept.
- Program Delivery: Stations & Guideways Dept.
- FY 2017 Budget: \$2.6M



Initial Construction Schedule

- Spring Summer 2017
- First 5 prioritized locations:
 - SW 170th Ave (Beaverton)
 - NW Division St (Gresham)
 - SE 10th & Washington (Hillsboro)
 - NE Hood St (Gresham)
 - SW 185th Ave (Hillsboro)



Enhancements

Typical enhancements at gated MAX crossings:

- Realigning sidewalks
- Making crossings more perpendicular to the rail
 - Constructed at 90-degrees
- Installing pedestrian-scale active warning signals & audible devices







Enhancements

Typical enhancements at gated MAX crossings:

- Pedestrian channelization
 - Directing pedestrians to safe crossings with pipe barriers
- New signs, striping and ADA tactile strips

 - NE Kelly Ave (Gresham)
 - NE 28th Ave (Hillsboro)
 - E 97th & Burnside
 - SW Merlo Rd/158th
 - West side only
