## RESOLUTION OF THE TRI-COUNTY METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION DISTRICT OF OREGON (TRIMET) APPOINTING AN INTERIM GENERAL MANAGER

WHEREAS, ORS 267.135 authorizes the TriMet Board of Directors (Board) to appoint a general manager; and

WHEREAS, the duties of the TriMet general manager are outlined in ORS 267.140 and include having full charge of the administration of the business affairs of the district; and

WHEREAS, to ensure continuity of operations and efficient and effective management and administration of the business affairs of the district, the TriMet Board desires to appoint an interim general manager to serve until a permanent general manager has been appointed; and

WHEREAS, Shelley Devine, TriMet's General Counsel since 2014, is fully informed of the needs of the district;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That Shelley Devine is appointed as Interim General Manager effective February 22, 2018, and shall serve until the Board appoints a permanent general manager.
