Pursuant to ORS 294.463, this in allows for the transfer of funds from the Contingency Fund to the Regional Fund is within TriMet's FY2018-2019 budget.
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5. Background

On May 23, 2018, the Board approved Resolution 18-05-39, adopting the FY2018-2019 annual budget and appropriating funds. The budget was based on the best available information at the time, as actual revenues and expenses are not known when the budget is developed. Historically during the fiscal year, TriMet transfers appropriations to match revised expenditure requirements. This revision is needed because a subsequent July 31, 2018, IGA with Metro provided \$2,000,000 for the Active Transportation/Safe Routes to Schools project and \$95,000 for the Enhanced Transit project.

- The \$2,000,000 for Active Transportation/Safe Routes Projects on the Primary Transit Supportive system is for project development activities for regional active transportation projects, including alignment analysis, preliminary engineering, design and environmental impact studies.
- The \$95,000 for Enhanced Transit is for selecting and designing a series of bus, roadway and Streetcar projects that will be advanced from project concepts through multiple phases of design in preparation for construction.

Financial Services and Budget & Grants have determined that these projects are best paid through the Regional Fund Exchanges organizational unit.
