### 5. Background

TriMet is committed to making the bus system accessible to passengers of all ages and abilities. A TriMet Accessible Bus Stops Plan will help TriMet and local jurisdictions identify and define locations for infrastructure investments, and prioritize policies, strategies and projects that will lead to enhanced ADA accessibility for all bus stops in the TriMet system. To create this Plan, an energetic public engagement process and the establishment of a plan advisory committee is needed, along with close coordination with local jurisdictions and other interested parties.

The Plan will examine TriMet's inventory of over 6000 bus stops, analyze the impacts of parking and establish strategies to improve paths of travel to bus stops. The final outcome will include a responsibility matrix, projects costs, implementable strategies and a time-line to bring all TriMet system bus stops to full ADA accessibility, or better. The Plan will be used to guide TriMet investments in bus stop infrastructure, and to inform and influence improvements to be implemented by partner jurisdictions.

To fund these planning activities, TriMet is pursuing an Oregon Department of Transportation and Oregon Department of Land Conservation and Development Joint Transportation Growth Management (TGM) Program Planning Grant. TGM project eligibility criteria require that the grant result in the creation of an "adoption-ready plan or land use regulation or amendments to an existing plan or land use regulation." In addition, the Grant Eligibility Requirements established through the TGM program requires the submission of "a resolution of support, meeting minutes, or authorized letter from the governing body of all applicants," along with grant application to document local support.

#### 6. Diversity

Not applicable at this phase of the grant application process.

## 7. Financial / Budget Impact

If awarded a TGM grant to create an Accessible Bus Stops Plan, TriMet will be responsible for providing 12% matching funds of the Plan's estimated budget of \$200,000. Consultant services needed to complete the Plan will be procured, contracted and directly reimbursed by the Oregon Department of Transportation, and will not directly impact TriMet's budget.

#### 8. Impact if Not Approved

If the Board chooses not to adopt this resolution, the Accessible Bus Stops Plan will not be eligible to receive funding from the Oregon Department of Transportation and Oregon Department of Land Conservation and Development Joint Transportation Growth Management Planning Grant program, the Plan may not qualify for other potential grant funding and the accessibility planning may not be undertaken.
