6. Background

At its January 25, 2017 meeting, the Board approved Resolution 17-01-04, authorizing award of a contract to RNL Design, Inc. (RNL) in the amount of \$5,000,000 for design services for the Project. That amount did not include any funding for future design services during construction because the amount necessary for that work could not be determined at that time. Staff advised the Board that it would return for approval prior to modifying the contract for the additional work. RNL subsequently was purchased by Stantec, and the contract was transferred to Stantec. At its August 8, 2018 meeting the Board approved Resolution 18-08-63, authorizing a modification with Stantec for design services during construction in the

amount of \$4,208,301.

At its June 26, 2019 meeting the Board approved Resolution 19-06-42, for a construction contract modification that included additional scope, as a result of commitment to an electrified bus fleet and related infrastructure, permit modifications, and a 10-month extension to the construction schedule. This Resolution modifies the design services contract to accommodate the expanded scope of the construction contract. This modification authorizes additional authority of \$3,900,000 for Stantec design services. The services will be authorized through negotiated task orders.

7. Procurement Process

The original contract was procured via a competitive Request for Proposals process.

8. Diversity

In its proposal, RNL expected to achieve 27% DBE participation by subcontracting out such areas of work as traffic engineering, survey services, permitting, landscape architecture, electrical engineering, geotechnical engineering, and a portion of architectural design. Currently, Stantec is achieving approximately 26% DBE participation. The work included in design services during construction anticipates above 35% participation. Stantec's workforce is 18% minority and 34% women.

9. Financial/Budget Impact

The increased contract amount is included in TriMet's FY2021 capital program budget.

10. Impact if Not Approved

TriMet's alternative would be to hire additional staff to complete the design work. This option is not preferred because this contract requires highly specialized professional expertise and addresses a short-term staffing need that will not exist after this work is complete.

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WHEREAS, TriMet has authority under ORS 267.200 to enter into a contract modification (Modification) with Stantec Architecture, Inc. (Stantec) for Design Services for TriMet's Powell Bus Garage Replacement Project (Project); and

WHEREAS, the total amount of the Modification exceeds the contract amount originally authorized by the TriMet Board of Directors (Board); and

WHEREAS, by Resolution dated October 25, 2017, the Board adopted a Statement of Policies requiring it to approve goods and services contracts obligating TriMet to pay in excess of \$1,000,000;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. That the Modification shall conform with applicable law.
- 2. That the General Manager or his designee is authorized to execute the Contract Modification in the amount not to exceed \$3,900,000, through the Modification's June 30, 2023 termination date.
